TREE CUTTING -- WIA Rules & Policies

• WHY:


- o To preserve-the natural beauty & health of the native ponderosa pine forest.
- o To prevent clear-cutting CLEAR CUTTING IS NOT ALLOWED.
- o To maintain property values.

• WHEN DO I NEED A PERMIT:

- o To cut only larger ponderosa pines (greater than 4" dia. at chest height) -
 - Beyond 30 feet from house and deck (outside wildfire defensible space).
 - Beyond 5 feet of driveway.

WHEN DO I <u>NOT NEED</u> A PERMIT:

- o To cut any <u>dead</u> trees or shrubs.
- o To cut any ponderosa pine less than 4" diameter at chest height.
- o To cut any tree or shrub within 30 feet of house or 5 feet of driveway.
- o To cut any other tree or shrub except ponderosa pine (scrub oak, spruce, etc).



Permits are free and may be obtained by calling WIA office at 488-2693.

- TO REDUCE WILDFIRE and INSECT (MPB) RISK, REMEMBER:
 - o Remove slash piles ASAP.
 - o Remove dead trees within 30 days.
 - o Wildfire fuel reduction takes priority over MPB concerns.
 - Remove all fresh cut pine from the property ASAP during the July 1 to October 1 MPB flight season.
