## **WPS Role in Covenant Violations**

WPS Officers will verify covenant violations after a complaint has been received and processed by the WIA staff for the following:

- Trailers, RV's, Boats
- Commercial vehicles
- Off drive parking
- Excess vehicles parked in driveway or owners parking on the street

WPS will not initiate any of these types of violations while conducting a vacation check or while on patrol.

WPS Officers can and should *initiate* covenant violations for violations that are concerns for public safety such as:

- Open pit fires (campfires)
- Fireworks
- Discharging firearms in Woodmoor Common areas
- Loose and Aggressive dogs

WPS Officers can and should *initiate* covenant violations for violations that are concerns for public safety when conducting a vacation check.

WPS Officers will respond after a complaint has been received and attempt to verify violations of public peace or nuisance violations such as:

- Barking dogs
- Loose dogs
- Loud parties
- After hours construction noise (7am to 7pm) on ACC approved projects

WPS Officers while on patrol should watch for construction projects underway and verify with the ACC Project Coordinator that the owners have approval for the project.
